“2.2.2 Gary J Schwarzmuller Service Award

This award, named after Gary Schwarzmuller, past Georgia Tech Department of Housing Director, is to recognize distinguished service and dedication to the Residence Hall Association organization over the course of a semester. Nominations may be made to the RHA Executive Board and the award shall be selected by the RHA Executive Board. Applications for this award are due November 13th, 2009 for the fall and April 2nd, 2010 to the RHA executive board for the spring. The recipient’s name shall be engraved in a plaque to be hung in the RHA office and \$150 gift certificate shall be presented to the recipient each semester by the President. There is no limitation on the number of times a resident may received the award. There is no requirement that this award be given every semester. (Established 1985)”

Schwarzmueller Award Nomination

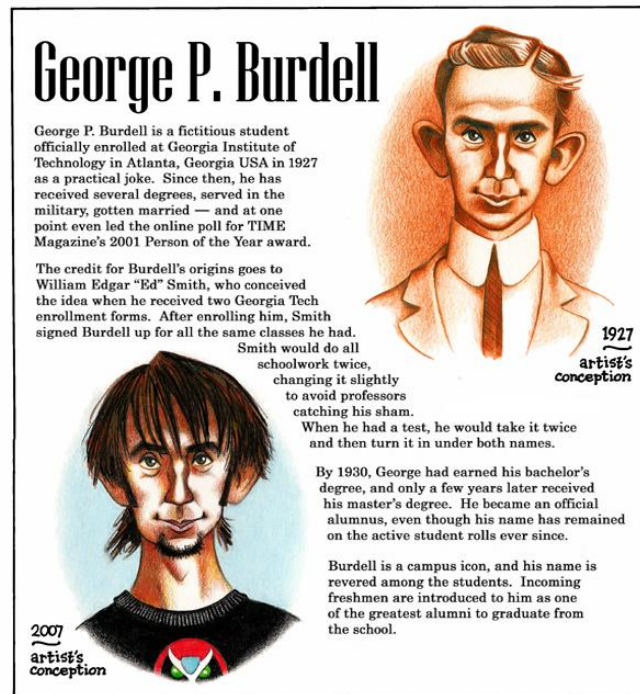
